

In autumn 2005, the organizers of Slovenian competition had launched the eighth run of competition. The topic was "Leaving and Arriving: Migration in Slovenia". We have received 25 projects, done by 37 pupils. The number of papers and pupils were almost similar to those in previous competition. These pupils were from 16 different schools from different parts of Slovenia. They have been working under supervision of 22 tutors.

Under the general topic pupils have found different titles for their papers. We can summarize these different titles into few groups like papers dealing Slovenes emigrated abroad, immigrants in Slovenia and commuters.

We are convinced that the role of the tutor is essential. We have received excellent papers within we could find a lot of enthusiasm and work of pupils and good leading and suggestions of mentors. But unfortunately on the other side we also have papers that do not fit into the frame of a topic. And in this kind of situation we are very sure about no role of tutor – he/she hasn't been presented anyway. We will try to find a way to work with tutors in seminar in autumn and will try to involve into this seminar good examples and experiences from previous competitions.
