Results of the SlovenianHistory Competition 2007/2008

In autumn 2007, the organizers of the Slovenian competition had launched the eighth round of their competition. The topic was "Perception of the consequences of World War I among Slovenes". We have received 17 projects, done by 35 students. The number of papers and students was similar to those in the previous years. These students came from 14 different schools from different parts of Slovenia. Some schools took part in the competition for the first time. They have been working under supervision of 19 tutors.

Under the general topic the students found different titles for there papers. We can summarize these different titles into few groups like changes in social life after WW1, impact of the war on population and economic impacts.

We are convinced that the role of the tutor is essential. We have received excellent papers within we could find a lot of enthusiasm and work of students and good leading and suggestions of the respective mentor. But unfortunately on the other side we also received papers that do not fit into the frame of a topic. And in this kind of situation we are very sure about no role of tutor. We will try to find a way to work with tutors in seminars in autumn and will try to involve into this seminar good examples and experiences from previous competitions.
