

Report of the Norwegian history competition 2012/2013

In 2012-2013, HIFO, the Norwegian Historical Association, organised the 14th history competition in Norway. The year 2013 marked the 100 anniversary of universal suffrage in Norway. In addition to the traditional competition 'My family and history', HIFO, in cooperation with the Stemmerettsjubileet, organised an additional competition called 'Participation in the democracy – 100 years of universal suffrage'.

Over the last three years, the Norwegian competition has had a stable participation between 600-800 participants every year. All in all, 733 students submitted their contributions to the competition. The number of entries was 715
