

**“Ukraine as a new life shore. Migrations in history of Ukraine”
Contest of history projects for pupils entitled**

All regions of Ukraine (from September 1 to December 25, 2010)

Information about 154 group students' historical researches, which had been presented at the local level were sent to the address of the contest organizers.

In total about 1200 students and 180 teachers participated in the contest, as well as local communities' representatives, parents and mass media.

The contest was aimed at forming in students multicultural competences by researching history of representatives of different ethnic minorities and religions at the local level, and namely:

Ethnic and religious diversity. Everyday life of different nationalities' representatives on the territory of Ukraine. (State policy, human rights. Stereotypes and prejudice. Conflicts. Identity. Language.

Economical relations. Migrations, assimilation, segregation, models of co-existence, cultural interpenetration.) The contest materials have been developed with the support of the experts from EUSTORY European Association.

The announcement about the contest was published in a separate newspaper, as well as in a web-bulletin and website of the Association “Nova Doba”.
