How did you decide on your topic?

For our research paper we conducted interviews with contemporary witnesses. The interview with Ángela impressed and surprised me. She lived during the Spanish Civil War and Franco's dictatorship. Thanks to her, we learnt about the hard life conditions caused by the persecution and punishments of the Republic's authorities.

Now, after having heard about and analyzed the atrocious life conditions, I see the future differently. Working on the past gave me a new perspective on the future.
